The City of Minneapolis is in the process of recruiting applicants to serve as Americorps VISTA members for the Promise Zone initiative. President Obama created the Promise Zone initiative to address the challenges of deep and persistent poverty, and Minneapolis was awarded the designation in April 2015.

The goal of the Minneapolis Promise Zone is to build capacity for the City and its partners to transform distressed communities in north Minneapolis by increasing racial equity, access to safe, affordable housing, economic development and employment; improving educational outcomes; and improving community health and safety. Americorps VISTA is the “domestic peace corps” and is a one-year opportunity to be a part of transformation in north Minneapolis. Members receive a monthly stipend and educational award at the end of the year of service. The following ten opportunities are available:
