The Policy and Procedure Committee met on October 28th. All committee members (Commissioners Singleton and Buss) were present as well as OPCR's Director Browne and Legal Analyst, Mr. Patrick. Agenda Items Discussed:

Ongoing Business

Research and Study Status Updates/ Pending Information Requests

- Mr. Patrick provided a status update on the progress of ongoing programs of research and study.

- The Coaching and Cultural Awareness studies are in rough draft form, which is representative of what the report will look like.
- There are a number of methods of getting the Cultural Awareness information out; in the post certification process have weighed the pros and cons on how these ideas may be implemented or put into practice.
- The current structure includes the introduction, research articles on learning styles, the plug and play components include information from other agencies and NACOLE, the implementation of the ideas generated from the report, followed by the structure section of the report. .
- There are no pending information requests at this time.

- The August PCOC meeting passed a motion to begin a Research and Study into Stop and Frisk Reporting and Data Collection. Presentation was provided by Sgt. Bantle and Lt. Hoth of the MPD Police Academy.

- Primary Points of discussion:
 - The MPD does stop and frisk but not without reason; the procedure is referred to as suspicious person/vehicle stops, or Terry investigative stops.
 - Types of contact include voluntary, citation, custodial arrest, detention and detention with pat down.
 - Detention involves temporary interference of a person's liberty; if further evidence is found the incident could lead to an arrest if there is reasonable suspicion.
 - The MPD Academy utilizes scenario based training, which incorporates suspicious person and vehicle stops.

- Legal updates on the law are provided to the MPD on a regular basis through the Minneapolis and Hennepin County Attorney's offices.
- Documentation of a Terry investigative stop should be made either through added remarks to the call in the CAD system, or through another method, unless CAPRS report or supplemental reporting is required.
- At the present time documentation is required however there is not a method of tracking or running a statistical report to monitor the effectiveness of the policy. However whenever a Terry investigative stop is performed it should be documented all of the time.
- Discussion continues on merits of this research and study as well as methods to gather information.

New Business

Discussion of Cases referred by Commission

- There were no new cases referred to the committee from the October PCOC meeting.

Moving Forward

- Next scheduled meeting is November 25th.

- The agenda will include status updates of existing programs of research and study, ongoing information requests, and further discussion of previously referred cases;
- New business will be determined based on referrals from Commission meetings.
