

# See hate-motivated speech and actions?



The City of Minneapolis seeks to be a welcoming place for all people. The City's Civil Rights Department has jurisdiction to investigate acts that discriminate or create a hostile environment based on religion, ethnicity, race, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, marital status and status with regard to public assistance. Other bias motivated conduct may constitute a violation of the criminal laws.

If you believe you are the victim of unlawful or threatening conduct, the City offers several options for filing complaints.
