3. Body-Worn Camera Pilot Program Grant ([15-00664](#))

Reporting back to Committee regarding authorizing the Police Department to submit a grant application by June 16, 2015, to the Bureau of Justice Assistance seeking up to \$600,000 in funding, including a required matching component of up to the grant award, to provide funds to develop, implement, and evaluate a comprehensive program for body-worn cameras by selected Police Department personnel, with input from the community and criminal justice system, to improve law enforcement and to enhance officer interaction with the public. PSCR&EM Committee empowered to determine the advisability of proceeding with the grant application submission, subject to ratification by the full City Council.
