Re: Minneapolis Charter

Dear Members of the Charter Commission:

In 2005, I sent to you correspondence dated July 28, August 16 & September 26. That correspondence addressed the problems of the current Minneapolis Charter and the way SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS are levied and how the appeals process works.

Subsequently, the Commission turned it over to the CITY ATTORNEY's OFFICE for interpretation, without a time frame for a response. It is 2007, and no response has been delivered. In 2005, it appeared to me that my concerns were treated as a "NUISANCE".

In view of the recent COURT OPINION, as it relates to this issue, I urge you to address it now because it will not go away. I also urge you to consider that any opinion by the CITY ATTORNEY, on this issue, at this time, will be tainted and as such will lack any objectivity.

For your information, the Court of Appeals Decision was entered on April 10, 2007. The CASE No. is: AO6-982 Juris Curiskis, Appellant, vs. City of Minneapolis, Respondent.
