**Supporting Information**

**A public hearing is scheduled for April 3<sup>rd</sup>, as required by HUD, to provide the public an opportunity to verbally comment to the City on the proposed 2012 Consolidated Plan. A 30 day public comment period is set for March 16 through April 14, 2012 for written comments to be received. The 2012 Consolidated Plan is the City's application to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for 2012 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnerships (HOME), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA). This year the Consolidated Plan updates the 2010-2014 Five-Year Strategy and amends the 2011 Consolidated Plan for ESG programming changes for the now-implemented 2009 HEARTH Act, including application for a second allocation of FY2011 ESG funds**
