HISTORY OF LOCATION

This licensee has operated at this location for approximately 2 years.

APPLICANT

The applicant is Stadium Pizza and Diner LLC. The sole shareholder is Joel Hunt.

POLICE REVIEW

Police Licensing and this Inspector have reviewed the expenses and source of funds reported in this application. The applicant has provided documentation showing adequate legal and traceable funding for this venture and has passed the criminal background check.

PREMISES

The proposed outdoor area is located on private property. The space contains 600 square feet located directly behind the building. The licensed premises space is compact and contiguous. The patio will consist of 4 high-top tables. No seating will be provided. The total capacity of this outdoor patio will be 40 persons.

BUSINESS PLAN/OPERATIONS

The applicant indicates that the outdoor patio will be open from 11:00 AM to 2:00 AM seven days a week. There will be no entertainment or speakers located in the outdoor patio.

PUBLIC HEARING SUMMARY

Seventeen notices were mailed to property owners and residents within 300 feet of the main door of the establishment on April 13, 2012. The public hearing is scheduled before the Regulatory, Energy & Environment Committee on April 30, 2012 at 1:30 PM in Room 317 City Hall.

RECOMMENDATION

The Licenses and Consumer Services Division recommends approving this application for a permanent expansion onto an outdoor patio located on private property.
