


2012 collection

of compostable yard bags and bundled brush ends the week of **Nov. 12**

Your garbage day in the week of Nov. 12 is the last 2012 collection for leaves, brush and other yard trimmings. Yard waste must be in compostable bags - paper (Kraft) or compostable plastic - or unbagged in a reusable container with sturdy handles. Set all yard waste next to your garbage cart by 6 a.m.

Fall street sweeping

mid-October to mid-November

Cars must be moved so crews can clear leaves from the streets. Signs will be posted at least 24 hours before towing begins. Signs will specify the day of the week that parking is banned and read "No Parking 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m."



Watch for "no parking" signs each day or if you can't, arrange with a friend for help.

Don't get towed

Find out when your street is scheduled for sweeping - in mid-October, check the schedule at www.minneapolismn.gov/streetsweep.

Remember, it's against the law and bad for our lakes to rake leaves into the street.
