Supporting Information

The Police Department requests permission to accept \$16,724 under the State's Department of Commerce *Auto Theft Prevention Program* grant. This is an amendment to the grant accepted in December 2011 that will be used to support the existing Auto Theft Prevention Program for two years for prosecuting auto thieves. The program also disseminates information department's "bait vehicles" and general information about auto theft prevention to deter auto theft crimes. This is the second amendment and includes funding for community education workshops in the 4th Precinct to help prevent motor vehicle theft.
