**Public Hearing Requirement:** A public hearing is required for this license application. 11 notices were mailed to property owners within 300 feet of the premises and E-mailed to the Northeast Park Neighborhood Association and Northeast Minneapolis Chamber of Commerce on August 13, 2012. Additionally, notices were posted on the buildings within 300 feet of the premises. The public hearing will be held on September 10, 2012, at the Regulatory, Energy and Environment Committee meeting.

**Background:** The applicant proposes to extend the hours of operation for their grocery and tobacco delivery service to 3:00 a.m. seven day per week. The business will consist of delivery operations only. There will be no service to customers at the business address.

## Findings as Required by the Minneapolis Licensing Code:

The Licenses and Consumer Services Division has analyzed the application and concludes that the application has answered the following:

A security plan that describes the security features, including personnel and equipment, that the applicant will employ and how they will be utilized:

The business is within a warehouse structure with one entrance into suite L-3 which is a double door that locks on close. There is no signage of the business on the exterior of the warehouse. The business is equipped with the required surveillance camera system. Delivery drivers will carry no more than twenty dollars cash. The 2<sup>th</sup> Police Precinct has discussed security issues with the applicant.

Description of how the applicant will maintain the orderly appearance and operation of the premises with respect to litter and noise:

Staff will remove litter daily. There are no residents in the area and no history of noise being a factor

Such other reasonable and pertinent information as the city council may require:

Tobacco products will be kept in locked cabinets and released to delivery drivers by managers only. Delivery drivers will check the ID of the customer for legal age prior to releasing the tobacco product.

Proximity to permitted or conditional residential uses.

Nature of the business and its impacts of noise, light and traffic.

There are no residences in the area

Conformance with applicable zoning regulations, including but not limited to use, yards, gross floor area and specific development standards.

The business is categorized as an I-2 Medium Industrial district.

History of complaints related to the use.

There are no significant police calls for service at this location.
