RESOLUTION ACCEPTING PROPERTY AND SERVICES DONATION

WHEREAS, the City of Minneapolis is generally authorized to accept donations of real and personal property pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 465.03 for the benefit of its citizens, and is specifically authorized to accept gifts and bequests for the benefit of recreational services pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 471.17; and

WHEREAS, the following persons and entities have offered to contribute the gifts set forth below to the city:

Minneapolis Public Schools	Donation of one safety camera and funding to cover the installation cost.

WHEREAS, no goods or services were provided in exchange for said donation;

WHEREAS, all such donations have been contributed to assist the city in public safety as allowed by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is appropriate to accept the donations offered.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MINNEAPOLIS MINNESOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

The donations described above are accepted and shall be used as part of the City's safety camera system, as an enhanced safety feature near the Minneapolis Public School's new facility in North Minneapolis. The camera will be placed midblock on Girard Avenue North between 23rd and 22nd Avenues.
