

## **Green Campus Phase I Launched in Fall of 2012**

Some of the Green Campus partners – City of Minneapolis, Minneapolis Public Schools (MPS), and Mississippi Watershed Management Organization - have identified a project area for a Phase I implementation of the Green Campus Initiative. The project area encompasses the Edison High School parking lot at the corner of 22<sup>nd</sup> Ave & Quincy Street NE and the Edison gym at the corner of 22<sup>nd</sup> Ave and Monroe Street. MWMO has engaged the services of Stantec, a professional design and engineering firm, to study the feasibility of a variety of stormwater management techniques that could be implemented in these two areas.

Working with the partners, Edison High School and representatives from the Holland neighborhood, Stantec has developed a menu of options from permeable pavers to tree trenches to underground water storage. Click on the documents below to get a closer look at what is being proposed:
