



### **Background/Supporting Information**

The desired outcome from this Request for Proposal and vendor selection process is to acquire and implement an Enterprise Land Management System to replace Kiva and consolidate the functionality of other existing systems related to the process of Land Management in the City.

Enterprise Land Management functionality is primarily required by process owners in ten City (10) Departments including; Regulatory Services, 911, Office of Emergency Management, Community Planning and Economic Development (CPED), Public Works, Assessors Office, Finance, Fire Department, Police Department and 311. In addition, such a system is utilized by City executives, elected officials and constituents.

The City is committed to increased inter-departmental transparency and collaboration, improved leverage of GIS and Geospatial enabled data, and the implementation of an enterprise land data store.

Upon final approval of the City's Permanent Review Committee, IT and Regulatory Services requests City Council approval to proceed with issuing the Request for Proposals (RFP) to secure a vendor for the purchase and implementation of the City of Minneapolis Enterprise Land Management System.
