The Target Foundation is providing \$6,650 in funding for the Police Department to sponsor training on Social Media to which we are inviting local law enforcement agency personnel. Food for the conference, up to \$3,350, has been approved by the Target grant and this use of funds has also been approved by the City's Finance Officer.

Up to \$4,950 of the grant can be used for consulting fees for the Police Department to work with a consultant to integrate social media with law enforcement into the mission of the department.
