Background Information:

The Minneapolis Advisory Committee on People with Disabilities advises and otherwise aids the Mayor, City Council and city departments on matters pertaining to public policy and the administration of programs, services and facilities for persons with a disability in

Minneapolis. The committee is composed of 15 members that are appointed to two-year terms. Eight (8) terms expire on December 31 of the odd numbered years and Seven (7) terms expire on even numbered years.
