### **Background and Supporting Information:**

The Evidence Packet is attached.

The license holder is in violation of Minneapolis Code of Ordinances Chapter 259.15 by failing to pay administrative fines in the amount of \$1,020.

On February 23, 2012, Mark Koursh signed an agreement to stay a portion his \$400 administrative fine issued on July 9, 2010 for violation of Minneapolis Code of Ordinance 341.250. The amount stayed, \$220, was contingent on Mr. Koursh have no same or similar violations within the next year. On June 3, 2012, Mr. Koursh was issued an \$800 administrative citation for violation of Minneapolis Code of Ordinance 341.250. On October 12, 2012, Mark Koursh was ordered by the Administrative Hearing Officer the remaining balance of the \$220 administrative fine, and additionally pay \$200 of the \$800 administrative fine, with \$600 stayed provided that Mr. Koursh completed a list of conditions outlined in the attached order. Mr. Koursh failed to complete any of the conditions stipulated by the Administrative Hearing Officer, and as a result, the full amount of the \$800 citation is now outstanding, and also the remaining \$220 balance of the previous \$400 administrative citation. The total outstanding amount of these citations is \$1,020.

**Recommendation:**

The Licenses and Consumer Services Division recommends that the Taxi Driver's license for Mark Bradley Koursh be revoked for nonpayment of administrative fines in the amount of \$1,020.
