Special Considerations:

The appointment/reappointment requests are for seats on the Senior Citizen Advisory Committee that are not ward specific.

Background Information:

The Senior Citizen Advisory Committee has 23 members according to their creating legislation and an additional 3 seats designated as Members at Large according to their bylaws.

13 members are ward appointments (of which need to be qualifying seniors – over 55). 10 appointments are Organizational Representatives of an organization that funds or provides key services to seniors. These Organizational Representatives need not be 55, nor do they have to be a resident of Minneapolis. 3 seats are Members at Large. The members at large do not need to be over 55, nor do they have to be a resident of Minneapolis.

Eleven regular two-year terms being on January 1 in odd numbers years and twelve regular two-year terms begin on January 1 in even numbered years. At large terms are two years long and begin on January 1.
