

Firearms/State Legislative Agenda:

Staff direction to report back to Committee of the Whole with proposed new language relating to the clarification of the State v. Yang decision.

Delete as a priority issue the language "Amend Minnesota law to clarify the definition of a "public place" for those carrying a pistol without a permit. In State v. Yang (2012) the Minnesota Supreme Court identified the need for this clarification when they found carrying a pistol without a permit in a private yard is not carrying a pistol in public, even when the person is not the owner of the property and was not invited by the owner."

Insert in lieu thereof: "Clarify that uninvited people and trespassers on private land may not circumvent Minnesota's permit to carry law."
