

Supporting Information

The Minneapolis City Attorney's Office ("MCAO"), Hennepin County Attorney's Office ("HCAO") and Hennepin County Community Corrections ("HCCC") wish to implement a pilot to determine if recidivism rates for chronic livability offenders city-wide can be further improved by providing active probation supervision resources for such offenders when appropriate. The probation officer will provide active supervision for a caseload of up to 40 chronic livability offenders from our city-wide caseload. The MCAO and HCAO will each contribute \$25,000, for a total of \$50,000 for the twelve month pilot.
