


### Supporting Information

The Criminal Justice Coordinating Committee (CJCC) began nearly 20 years ago to find common solutions in the area of criminal justice; administrative expenses for the CJCC were funded by Hennepin County. On March 6, 1998 the City Council entered into an agreement with Hennepin County to provide administrative assistance to the CJCC. Per the agreement, payment allotment for expenditures is funded 80% by the County and 20% by the City. The City's portion is divided between the City and the County as follows: 60% City Attorney's Office (CAO) and 40% Minneapolis Police Department (MPD). We have worked to reduce CJCC costs and will continue to work toward that goal. It is important to continue the City's involvement and participation in the CJCC. Therefore the CAO and MPD are seeking authorization for the proper City officials to execute an amendment to the agreement with Hennepin County from February 1, 2013 to January 31, 2016 with a total compensation not to exceed \$75,000.
