Public Hearing Requirement: A public hearing is required for this license application. 83 notices were mailed to residents and property owners within 300 feet of the premises, and e-mailed to Windom Community Council and Hale, Page, Diamond Lake Business Association on March 13, 2013. The public hearing will be held on Thursday, April 4, 2013, at the Regulatory, Energy and Environment Committee meeting.

Background: Toppers Pizza has been licensed as a food manufacturer since June 5, 2012 and there are 12 seats in the establishment for customers waiting for their food orders. There was one complaint during this period of time they have held a food manufacturer license. Toppers Pizza does not have any entertainment.

Findings as Required by the Minneapolis Licensing Code: The Licenses and Consumer Services Division has analyzed the application and concludes that the application has answered the following:

1. A security plan that describes the security features, including personnel and equipment, that the applicant will employ and how they will be utilized.
Toppers Pizza has had a security plan review with 5th Police Precinct Inspector Tony Diaz. Security cameras are installed on the exterior of the building to monitor any outside activities which also allows the General Manager to view any activity outside from the interior of the restaurant. A silent alarm is installed in the front and the rear of the kitchen area in the event of any situations that would escalate from direct confrontation.

2. Description of how the applicant will maintain the orderly appearance and operation of the premises with respect to litter and noise.

Toppers Pizza does not have any live entertainment. They clean the premises and parking areas twice per day.

3. Such other reasonable and pertinent information as the City Council may require.

Proximity to permitted or conditional residential uses.

Nature of the business and its impacts of noise, light and traffic.

Toppers Pizza is adjacent to residential uses on one side of their premises. The rest of their premise is in a commercial area.

Conformance with applicable zoning regulations, including but not limited to use, yards, gross floor area and specific development standards.

The business is categorized as a Food Manufacturer which is a permitted use in the C1 district.

RECOMMENDATIONS (pending public hearing):

The Licenses and Consumer Services Division makes the following recommendation regarding this application to extend hours:

Grant the license applicant the following amended extended hours: Open until 3:00 a.m., seven days a week.

This is an annually reviewed license. These hours will be reviewed at the next license renewal period. It will be possible to restrict the hours further if there are violations related to the Extended Hours License.
