The National Network of Hospital-based Violence Intervention Programs (NNHVIP) has awarded the Minneapolis Youth Violence Intervention Program (MYVIP) the 2012 Marla Becker Scholarship. The scholarship is awarded annually to a new or emerging hospital-based violence intervention program. Scholarship winners receive financial support to visit an established NNHVIP member program and participate in a 2-day on-site training. The award will be used by MYVIP staff from the health department, Hennepin County Medical Center, and North Memorial Hospital to off-set travel costs to Boston to receive training from the Massachusetts Violence Intervention Advocacy Program.
