Dear Executive Committee Members:

I am very pleased to nominate Nuriya P. Rivera-Vandermyde for the position of Director of Regulatory Services for the City of Minneapolis for the unexpired term beginning May 29, 2013, and ending January 1, 2014, and for a new two-year term beginning January 2, 2014. Upon your concurrence with this appointment, I request that you forward this to the Regulatory Energy and Environment Committee for City Council Action.

Ms. Rivera-Vandermyde brings 15 years of executive experience in compliance and regulation in both the public and private sectors. For nearly 10 years, Ms. Rivera-Vandermyde worked in various roles with the government of Puerto Rico and plaintiffs to comply with federal-court orders to improve and reform the delivery of healthcare in the Puerto Rican correctional system, as part of resolving one of the longest-standing class-action lawsuits in the United States. During that period, she served for five years as CEO and board president of the private, non-profit entity that was created by court agreement to transition the provision of correctional healthcare away from the government of Puerto Rico, which had chronically failed to comply with court orders to improve the system.

Her proven understanding of compliance and legal background together with her strategic planning, organizational leadership and interpersonal skills will be a tremendous asset to the Department of Regulatory Services and the City of Minneapolis. Thank you for your consideration.
