Hopkins – St. Louis Park – Minneapolis **Regional Sanitary Sewer Improvements** Minneapolis: Cedar Lake Area

Project Information as of March 2013

Project Summary and Need

- The Metropolitan Council approved a Facility Plan in February 2010 to reconstruct the wastewater pump station in Hopkins and to rehabilitate and construct a new force main sewer interceptor from the Hopkins pump station through St. Louis Park and part of Minneapolis.
- These improvements are required to maintain a reliable system for conveying wastewater from each of the three communities.
- Work on the Cedar Lake Area Sewer Improvements Project began in early 2013 and is currently scheduled to be completed by the end of 2013. The new force main in the Cedar Lake Area will be constructed along portions of the Hwy. 7 South Service Rd., France Ave., Sunset Blvd., Depot St., W. 28th St., Xerxes Ave. S., and W. 29th St.
- Additional work in Minneapolis includes the Calhoun-Isles Area (construction occurred from summer 2012 to early 2013) and the East Isles Area (construction currently anticipated in 2015).

Cedar Lake Project Areas

- The force main follows a new alignment along Xerxes Ave. S. (rather than the alley west of Xerxes Ave. S.).
- At Kenilworth Trail and W. 28th St., the force main alignment continues east along a similar alignment as the existing force main.
- The force main follows a new alignment along France Ave. S. and Sunset Blvd. to Depot St. (rather than Lake St. and St. Louis Ave.).
- Sections of force main not slated for rehabilitation will be removed or abandoned in place.

Estimated Construction Timeline

- Early March through early June: Depot St. between Sunset Blvd. and St. Paul Ave.
- Late April through early June: Kenilworth Trail/Dean Court
- Early May through mid-July: W. 28th St., Xerxes Ave., W. 29th St.
- Early June through early October; Westbound Sunset Blvd. between Depot St. and France Ave.
- Early June through early July: Park Siding Park restoration
- Mid-June through late December: France Ave., Hwy. 7 South Service Rd.
- Late December through mid-January: Abandonment of existing sewer pipe
- Late January 2014: Overall project completion
