Budget Pressures

Budget Book Page A13

■ ***Funding for Capital Equipment***

- Deferred maintenance and replacements due to budget pressures in recent years
- No comprehensive planning or funding mechanism for non-infrastructure capital, including equipment and technology
- Capital Asset Request System (CARS) process implemented for 2014
- Uses a five-year planning horizon similar to the Five-Year Capital Program (CLIC)
- For this first five-year cycle, the City received requests from departments totaling \$76.5 million
- For 2014, the requests totaled \$22.5 million with fleet equipment representing \$9.5 million. This budget recommends funding of \$8.9 million for 2014.
- For years 2015 – 2018, the City plans to fund approximately \$5 million per year.
