



Year-to-Date Outcomes for Dogs in KH (Power Dogs/ Shy Fearful)

January 1 to June 30 data

The canines in the Kennel Holding (KH) area of the animal shelter are typically the power breeds (pit bulls, Rottweilers, and mildly shy or fearful dogs). MACC does not adopt these dogs to the general public because we currently do not have the staffing to adequately behaviorally evaluate these animals or screen potential adopters. Animals in KH are transferred to one of our 46 approved rescue groups.
