Public Hearing Requirement: A public hearing is required for this license application. 29 notices were mailed to residents and property owners within 300 feet of the premises. The neighborhood and business associations received notices by email.

Background: The applicant proposes to extend the hours of operation for their restaurant and sidewalk café from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. seven days per week. Spyhouse coffee does not serve alcoholic beverages, nor does it provide entertainment.

Findings as Required by the Minneapolis Licensing Code:

The Licenses and Consumer Services Division has analyzed the application and concludes that the application has answered the following:

A security plan that describes the security features, including personnel and equipment, that the applicant will employ and how they will be utilized:

Spyhouse Coffee will utilize a video surveillance system with a live feed. Inside and outside, to include the parking area is well lit. Windows are maintained clear of obstructions. Staffing will include a minimum of 2 employees. The 2th Police Precinct has discussed security issues with the applicant.

Description of how the applicant will maintain the orderly appearance and operation of the premises with respect to litter and noise:

Staff will remove litter daily within a 100 foot radius of the business. Staff is trained to do rounds inside and outside every 15 minutes removing any litter.

Description of how the business will have people exit the establishment at closing time and during an emergency that requires all people to exit the establishment quickly:

The Shift Leader will be the designated head of security and will ensure patrons exiting the premises do not linger. Spyhouse Coffee indicates that they will close promptly at the prescribed 11:00 p.m. In the event of an emergency, the Shift Leader will ensure safe, quick evacuation of the premises.

Such other reasonable and pertinent information as the city council may require:

Upon request, the licensee shall meet representatives of the City of Minneapolis to discuss any safety, security or operational concerns.

**Proximity to permitted or conditional residential uses.
Nature of the business and its impacts of noise, light and traffic.**

There are no residences within the same block as the restaurant.

Conformance with applicable zoning regulations, including but not limited to use, yards, gross floor area and specific development standards.

The business is categorized as a food restaurant which is a permitted use in the I-2 Medium Industrial District/ Industrial Living Overlay District.

History of complaints related to the use.

There are no significant police calls for service at this location.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Business Licenses staff recommends approval of the application for an Extended Hours license for Spyhouse coffee.
