The Department of Homeland Security distributes grants to states, territories, urban areas and transportation authorities under these programs to bolster national preparedness capabilities and protect critical infrastructure. These funds will be allocated in 6 primary investment priorities;

CBRNE (Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, Explosive's), strengthen planning, EOC/Common Operating expenses, Interoperable communications, Law Enforcement Training Plan and Public Notification Systems.

The grant award is specific to projects and activities identified in the investment justifications for each specific grant and cannot be re-allocated to other activities without prior state approval. The grant performance period will be January 1, 2014 through June 20, 2015
