

Background/Supporting Information:

This matter and subsequent claim arise out of a trip and fall accident that occurred on October 12, 2009. On that date, R-D Systems employee Beatrice Johnson was crossing Summer Street between McKinley Place and Cleveland Avenue in Minneapolis. At that place Ms. Johnson fell due to a pothole in the street.

As a result of the trip and fall, claimant Travelers Indemnity Company, paid workers' compensation benefits to the employee in excess of \$27,000.00.

Following a Conciliation Court Judgment in the amount of \$10,000.00 in favor of Travelers Indemnity Company, post-judgment interest against the City has accrued totaling \$350.00. We request the authority to issue a draft for \$10,350.00 in full and final payment of the judgment in this matter.
