Acceptance of the low bid of Thomas and Sons Construction, Inc. for an estimated expenditure of \$1,307,495.50 to furnish and deliver all labor, materials and incidentals necessary for Construction of ADA Pedestrian Ramps for the Minneapolis Public Works Paving Division, as follows:
