

February 2012

- Year-long staff and stakeholder process to develop the plan
- Final product: **a recommended list of strategies from each focus area that can guide Minneapolis towards our emissions reduction targets**


Minneapolis Community GHG Reduction Targets

- Comprehensive Plan a significant upcoming policy document




Waste & Recycling

- Next steps on commercial, multifamily recycling
- Explore expanding organics collection

Next steps

- Priorities are being implemented across City departments – policy makers may find decision points in multiple Council committees
- Energy Pathways recommendation provides a valuable **implementation tool** for near-term action in the Buildings & Energy sector
- Sustainability staff will track progress on **strategies and emissions** annually through Sustainability Indicators, Results Minneapolis and updates as needed
