

Background/Supporting Information

Claimants Musa-Agboneni and PMA Properties LLC allege that MPD SWAT team caused approximately \$220,000 of damages to their rental property located at 3807 Aldrich Avenue North while responding to a report of an individual with a gun. The parties have negotiated a proposed settlement in the amount of \$75,000, including all claims for damages, attorneys' fees and costs. The parties involved believe that the proposed settlement is in the best interests of the City and recommend approval by this Committee and the City Council.
