The Hennepin County Board of Commissioners voted to fund at least five industry-specific and geographically-targeted job fairs in 2014. The funds are administered through the Hennepin-Carver Workforce Investment Board (WIB), and the job fairs will be managed by the City of Minneapolis Employment and Training. The events will target low-income and unemployed residents of Minneapolis and neighboring suburbs, particularly those in geographic areas with concentrated racial and employment disparities. Organizers anticipate 100 employers and 2,000 attendees.
