This matter came on for a License Settlement Conference (LSC) on Thursday March 27, ²⁰¹⁴~~2013~~ at 10:00 a.m. in Room 1-C of City Hall, 350 South Fifth Street, Minneapolis, Minnesota 55415. 2014 gw
 Appearing for the City of Minneapolis were Grant Wilson, Manager of Business Licensing and Richard J. Tuffs Lead License Inspector. Appearing for the license holder Pedal Pub Twin Cities were Lisa Staplin, City Manager, Al Boyce Managing Partner.

The LSC meeting was called to discuss pedal car driver behavior, pedal car safety issues and to address the number of complaints received in 2013. Based upon the agreement between the parties and all of the files and records contained herein, it is hereby recommended that the Committee make the following findings of Fact, conclusions and Recommendations:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. During the year 2013 there were 38 complaints relating to the commercial pedal cars operating in Minneapolis.

CONCLUSIONS

1. That most of the 38 complaints received regarding Pedal Pub most of which were related to the driver's inability to maintain proper control of the passengers at all times while piloting the vehicle.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That Twin Cities Pedal Pub is allowed to continue to operate pursuant to its Commercial Pedal Car License, subject to compliance with the following conditions:

1. The licensee shall ensure that all the commercial pedal car pilots are trained and adhere to city ordinances relating to traffic regulations, Commercial Pedal Car operation requirements and Twin Cities Pedal Pub's Pilot's Policy and Procedure Manual.
2. The licensee shall ensure that the commercial pedal car pilots properly dispose of trash at their assembly locations and any left-over beverages are dumped in the appropriate container on board the commercial pedal car and at no time will any beverage be dumped on any city property.
3. The licensee will conduct monthly covert, self-monitoring observations of Twin Cities Pedal Car tours and document the dates, times, locations and observations. These documents will be made available to city license inspectors.
4. The licensee will institute an employee training program with emphasis on (1) alcohol awareness; (2) alcohol service control; (3) patron behavior; (4) sound level control for both sounds created by patrons and amplified devices.
5. The licensee will modify sound systems to allow additional small speakers so that volume can be lowered.

Pedalpub – Twin Cities LLC understands that the holding of a business or liquor license in the City of Minneapolis is both a privilege and a responsibility. A minimum standard shall be met in order to hold such a license. One minimum standard is that a license holder is responsible to ensure that its business operates in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations. It is understood and agreed that any violation of the above Recommendations shall constitute just and proper cause for the immediate imposition of any stayed penalties. It is further understood that compliance with the above Recommendations is a requirement for continuing to hold a license and that failure to comply with any of these conditions may result in additional adverse license action.

I have read and understand the above findings of fact, conclusions, and recommendations. I agree with their contents and I agree with the above noted Recommendations. I understand that the failure of my business to adhere to this agreement may be cause for further suspension, revocation, or denial of my license. I understand that this report must be accepted and approved by the Minneapolis City Council and Mayor.
