TO THE CITY COUNCIL:

Permission is requested to Infill boulevard areas, on the North and East side of the building, with rubber permeable pavers. The existing sod does not survive due to high pedestrian volumes, lack of sunlight due to adjacent structures and salt from adjacent parking ramp, and is replaced over the summer for aesthetic reasons and also after the sod dies and shrinks it is a possible hazard at the edge of the sidewalk. Vast pavers are used in a small dog park one block to the west and we would use the same product to have some continuity in the area. Vast Pavers, formerly of Minneapolis, has changed to Azek pavers but continues to offer the same products. The pavers will also hold up to pedestrian traffic and salt without any issue.
