City Ordinances affected

- The Minneapolis Code of Ordinances
 - **Title 10 Food Code, Chapter 188 – Administration and Licensing** (*188.450 Toilet facilities required – repealed*)
 - **Title 14 Liquor and Beer, Chapter 364 – Liquor Regulations** (*364.110 Restroom facilities required – amended*)
 - **Title 14 Liquor and Beer, Chapter 368 – Beer Regulations** (*368.90 Restroom facilities – repealed*)

Redundant text

- Requirements already exist in State Food Code and Building Code
- Fixtures (toilets, toilet seats, urinals), room finishes, handwashing sinks, lighting, doors, gender specific requirements, etc.
- Exception
 - Floor Drain

Amended text

- Reference that restroom facilities must comply with applicable code, statute, rule and regulation in “on-sale” liquor or beer establishments

Benefits

- Automatically incorporates state revisions
- 2015 Building code allows flexibility
- Family/Assisted toilet facilities
 - More practical and compassionate solution
