



Request for City Council Committee Action from the Department of Information Technology

To: The Honorable John Quincy, Chair, Ways and Means Committee

Subject: Bentley Systems, Inc., C-24593

Recommendation: Authorize proper City officials to

- a) Extend contract, C-24593, with Bentley Systems, Inc. for the support and maintenance of the enhanced Bentley Enterprise License Subscription (ELS) for five additional years, through December 31, 2017,
- b) Increase the contract \$775,000, for a new not-to-exceed total of \$1,923,848 over the life of the contract, and
- c) Update Terms and Conditions to reflect current standards

Previous Directives: September 2, 2011 - Committee recommends that the proper City officers be authorized to amend contract C-24593 with Bentley Systems, Inc., to provide licenses, maintenance and support for the Bentley SELECT software application used by the Public Works Department, as follows:

- a) Extend contract period to December 31, 2014; and
- b) Increase contact amount by \$650,000, for a new not-to-exceed amount of \$1,214,002.

April 4, 2008 - Committee recommends the Bentley Systems Inc. contract be amended for annual support and maintenance of Computer-Aided Civil Engineering Application for the duration of its use not to exceed \$150,000.

April 13, 2007 - Committee authorizes City officers to execute a new contract with Bentley Systems to expire 12/31/08 in the amount of \$212,610. This contract is in lieu of the expired contract C-17010.

Financial Impact

Yes. Funding for this request is through the Information Technology allocation model.

Supporting Information

In 2007, the City originated a contract, C-24593, with Bentley Systems, Inc. to provide licenses, maintenance and support for the Bentley SELECT software application used by the Department of Public Works. The current contract is set to expire December 31, 2014 and has a total contract value of \$1,148,848.

The Bentley suite of products is Public Works' main business system for capital project design, publication of project information and map data editing and extraction. Since the Bentley application is also used by other governmental agencies (Hennepin County and the Minnesota Department of Transportation) that Public Works interacts with frequently, the City can share data effectively and efficiently.

Bentley is a leader in the industry for civil engineering software solutions. The application exceeds 99.99% uptime and meets the City's current and future business needs. Retaining Bentley is essential to the completion of Public Works projects already in progress. The proposed contract includes an estimated seven percent annual increase.

Information Technology (IT) and Public Works requests amending the contract from the current version (Bentley SELECT) to the enhanced Bentley Enterprise License Subscription (ELS) to provide expanded training and application functionalities needed by Public Works which include:

- Unlimited usage of the entire Bentley ELS portfolio of products
- Bentley Learn (training/learning)
- Virtual Training capability
- Online Information Access
- Online Remote Learning
- Performance Consulting Days (10 days)
- Learning Conference Registration Fees (unlimited)
