The 2015-19 HUD Consolidated Plan is the City's application and statement to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on how the City will utilize Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnerships (HOME), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) funding to be made available by HUD for community development and housing activities that provide a benefit to the City's low- and moderate-income households and address slum/blight issues.**
