

CREATE EVENT SPONSOR PERMIT

- Solidify the role of Event Sponsor
- Graded fee scale
 - \$87 Events with 1-10 vendors
 - \$174 Events with 11-20 vendors
 - \$261 Events with 20+ vendors
- Includes One Free Short-Term Permit
- Sponsor may list vendors of low-risk beverages meeting specific criteria under their own permit



Example: Wine Tasting Event

50 Wine Vendors & 2 Food Vendors

Currently

52 vendors x \$87 = \$4,524

Proposed

Sponsor Permit = \$261

2 food vendors x \$87 = \$174

Total Fees \$435



Event Sponsor Permit

- Conform to State Statute
- Sponsor responsibility
- Make fees more accurate and equitable
- Increase efficiency



INCREASE LATE FEE

Applications are due 10 business days

- Current late fee (50%) - \$43.50
- Increased late fee (100%) - \$87.00

Provide incentive to submit on time



REDUCE FEES

Minneapolis Convention Center

- Experienced Event Management
- Committed Partner
- MCC Event Coordinators
- Purchased Hand Sinks for Rental

Fee Reduction of 50% for all Permits
