

This lawsuit arises out of an incident that occurred at Patrick Henry High School on January 12, 2010. Plaintiff Dontae Thomas, a student at the school, was called into an office to speak with Officer Victor Mills and Officer Tyrone Barze. A physical altercation occurred in the office. Plaintiff brought suit against the Officers and the City, alleging claims of excessive force and unreasonable seizure.

After negotiations with Plaintiff's attorneys, we have negotiated a tentative settlement of the lawsuit in the amount of \$140,000, of which \$25,000 will be payable to Dontae Thomas and \$115,000.00 will be payable to his attorneys. We believe that this settlement is in the best interests of the City and recommend its approval.
