

Community Impact

Background/Supporting Information

Plaintiff David Paradeise claims that on June 15, 2014, a Minneapolis Police Officer unreasonably sprayed him with chemical spray, thereby violating his constitutional rights. He also alleges two claims against the City. On February 18, 2015, Defendants made a Rule 68 Offer of Judgment in the amount of \$7,500.00, plus reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred prior to that date. This offer was accepted by Mr. Paradeise. The parties have agreed that the fees and costs of Mr. Paradeise's attorneys can be satisfied with a payment of \$26,772.10, pending City Council approval.

For the foregoing reasons the City Attorney's Office recommends that the Council authorize payment to David Paradeise on the Rule 68 Offer of Judgment in the amount of \$7,500.00, and authorize settlement of the claim for attorney's fees with payment to her attorneys, Gaskins Bennett Birrell Schupp LLP, in the amount of \$26,772.10, and authorize the City Attorney's Office to execute any documents necessary to effectuate settlement.
