4,000 tons Gray/Black Class "A" Aggregate per ton \$35.65



I am responding to the sole bid received by Dresser Trap Rock Inc., to provide Gray Class A Aggregate to the City. I contacted the sales representative at Marin Marietta, the other company who typically puts in a bid for this material, to see why they did not place a bid this year and he explained to me that Martin Marietta did not submit a bid this year because the City requirements, while achievable, require a slowdown in production rates and this year they have too much work and do not have the ability to produce the material the City has specified.

However, he told me that Martin Marietta is purchasing a new primary crusher and will be able to provide the material that the City specifies in 2016 and they plan to start submitting their bid again.

Based on this, it is my recommendation that the City move forward in awarding the bid to Dresser Trap Rock Inc., to Class A Aggregate to the City of Minneapolis.
