**Police Review**

Minneapolis Police Licenses have reviewed the financial and criminal histories of the applicant. They have determined that the applicant meets the minimum ordinance requirements.

**Business Plan/Operations/ Premises**

The applicant is requesting to upgrade their level of entertainment from a Class E to a Class C-1 license. They plan on offering low-key, jazz-oriented live music on primarily Thursday to Sunday evenings but reserve the right for other evenings. The music would start at 8:00 p.m. and end at 11:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturdays and 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Sundays. Employees will continue to provide security for the venue.

There will not be a stage added to the location. Tables will be moved to provide space for the musicians to perform. This space will be returned to restaurant seating when entertainment is not offered. This will still meet the bar area requirement for under 30% bar area.

**Public Hearing**

A public hearing will be held at the CDRS committee on Tuesday, March 24, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. Notices have been sent to residents within 600 feet of the entrance to the Bad Waitress. Notices have also been sent to the Whittier Alliance Neighborhood group and the Whittier Business Association. The applicant will be attending a Whittier Alliance meeting before the CDRS meets on March 24, 2015.
