



## Request for City Council Committee Action From the Department of Convention Center and Procurement

**Subject:** **Official Publication No. 7782 - Bids for Minneapolis Convention Center Waste Hauling**

**Recommendation:**

We wish to extend contract C-37095 with Allied Waste Service of North America (d/b/a Republic Services of the Twin Cities) to year three of the three year contract. We also recommend an increase and an amendment to Contract No. C-37095 in the amount of \$95,000.00 for a new total contract estimated expenditure of \$285,000 to provide waste hauling services for the Minneapolis Convention Center for the third year of the contract.

**Original Contract allowed for an extension for an additional year through August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016.**

All terms and conditions remain the same.

Further recommend the proper City Officers be directed to execute an amendment to this contract.

**Background/Supporting Information;**

In a Council Action of June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2013 award was made to the low bidder of Allied Waste Service of North America (d/b/a Republic Services of the Twin Cities) on Official Publication No. 7782 for Waste Hauling at the Minneapolis Convention Center. The original contract allows the MCC at its sole discretion to extend the contract for two additional years. This is the second contract extension (year three) through August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016. The estimated expenditures for year three (\$95,000) is the same as year one and year two.
