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

In the Matter of Community Action of Minneapolis, Inc.

This matter was before the Office of Administrative Hearings pursuant to a Notice and Order for Prehearing Conference and Hearing filed November 4, 2014. The matter involves the appeal of Community Action of Minneapolis, Inc. from the Minnesota Department of Human Services notice of termination for cause of the corporation's recognition and designation as a Community Action Agency and all related state and federal grant contracts dated September 26, 2014.

The matter was scheduled to be heard on May 18, 19, and 20, 2015 by Administrative Law Judge, Tammy L. Pust. On May 11, 2015, Counsel for Community Action of Minneapolis filed a Motion to Withdraw Appeal. On May 12, 2015, Judge Pust closed the record and returned the file to the Commissioner of Human Services with an Order of Dismissal dated May 11, 2015 dismissing the matter with prejudice. The Order was labeled as not public. On May 20, 2015, Judge Pust sent the Commissioner a corrected Order removing the non-public designation.

The Commissioner of Human Services, based upon the entire record of this proceeding, Minnesota law and regulations, and the public policy of this state, makes the following:

ORDER

It is hereby ordered, that this matter is dismissed with prejudice and that the termination of the recognition and designation of Community Action of Minneapolis, Inc. as a Community Action Agency and all state and federal grant contracts is **AFFIRMED**.
