Police Review:

Minneapolis Police Licenses and the 5th Precinct have reviewed the financial, criminal history and security plans for the applicant. They have determined they meet the minimum ordinance requirements.

Premises/ Business Plan/Operations:

The premises will not change from the on sale wine with strong beer license application. The applicant plans to host wedding and special events on weekend nights. They will remove tables and chairs to accommodate dancing and a Disc jockey. The applicant is also applying for on sale liquor with Sunday sales license. They currently hold an on sale wine with strong beer license. Liquor would offer as part of their usual menu options and not just for special events. The applicant has had no violations or complaints since acquiring their current alcohol license.
