Subject:

Revenue contract with the University of Minnesota for bomb detection at the TCF Stadium for 2015 Vikings Football games

Description:

Authorize a revenue agreement for up to \$23,715 with the University of Minnesota for the City of Minneapolis Police department to provide two Bomb Unit technicians and one Police Officer K-9 handler, for bomb detection security services for ten Vikings Football games at the TCF Stadium during the 2015 season.

Previous Actions:

The Minneapolis Police department has been providing bomb detection security services for the Minnesota Vikings at the Metrodome since 2007 and now at TCF Stadium since 2014.

Ward/Neighborhood/Address:

Background/Analysis:

The Police Department will provide two Bomb Unit Technicians and one K-9 Police handler, compensated at \$93 per hour for an estimated 8.5 hours per game totaling up to \$23,715. This includes 10 home Vikings football games. The revenue is budgeted in the MPD's 2015 budget.
