Description:

Accepting the federal Certified Local Government (CLG) grant to:

- a. Conduct designation studies and surveys of properties associated with under-documented groups,
- b. Prepare a Native American historical context statement and reconnaissance survey supplement, and
- c. Appropriate CPED-Development Services Division budget funds, increasing the Revenue Budget for the Community Planning and Economic Development Agency federal fund (01300) by \$34,921.

Background/Analysis:

The grant funds will provide resources to designate and survey properties associated with under-documented groups as well as prepare a Native American historical context statement and reconnaissance survey supplement. The Certified Local Government (CLG) grant is a federal grant administrated through the Minnesota State Historical Preservation Office on the MN Historical Society. Since 1983 as a Certified Local Government, the City of Minneapolis has been eligible to apply for, and has received grants for projects such as context statements, landmark designations, and historic resource surveys.
