Settlement of Workers' Compensation Claim of Jeffrey S. Boeltl v. City of Minneapolis

Description:

Approving the settlement of this Workers' Compensation claim by payment of \$100,000.00 payable to Jeffrey S. Boeltl and his attorneys, Meuser & Associates, from Fund/Org. 06900-1500100-145400 and authorizing the City Attorney's Office to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the settlement.

Background/Analysis:

This claim arises out of multiple work related injuries suffered by Jeffrey S. Boeltl while he was employed as a Police Officer during his employment with the Minneapolis Police Department from June 24, 1991 to February 18, 2015. As a consequence of his work-related injuries at the City of Minneapolis and corresponding permanent physical restrictions, Mr. Boeltl is entitled to a number of benefits through workers' compensation.

Any settlement in excess of \$75,000 must be approved by the Council. Following negotiations and a mediation with his attorney, we have reached a tentative settlement of Mr. Boeltl's workers' compensation claim on a full, final and complete basis in the amount of \$100,000.00. This proposed settlement has been discussed with the Police Department and it is in agreement with the terms. We believe that the settlement is in the best interests of the City and recommend approval by this Committee.
