Background/Analysis:

The draft Creative City Road Map exhibition was presented at a public open house on September 17. Following the open house, the Creative City Road Map exhibit will be hosted at various locations targeted to reach underserved communities, throughout Minneapolis, for one week at each location. In addition, there will be public "loop back" events at most of these locations during the exhibit period.
